Animals are to be dropped off and picked up during kennel hours

Monday – Friday: 7:15am – 11:30am
1:30pm - 5:30pm
Saturday: 8:00am – 12:30pm
Sunday: CLOSED

What You Need To Know Before Making a Reservation

- All pets should have current vaccines done at least 2 weeks prior to boarding.
 - **Dog:** Canine Distemper Combination, Bordetella, Rabies, and Bivalent Influenza vaccines
 - **Cat:** Feline Distemper Combination and Rabies vaccines

- All pets must have an annual exam done by one of our doctors.

We advise you to reserve boarding in advance; especially for Holidays, Spring Break, and Summer Break; as these times are very busy.

What you Should Bring

- We recommend that you bring your pets' usual food as some pets are not tolerant of diet changes.
- Any medications in the original bottles.

An exam may be required to dispense medications that were not prescribed here.

What Not To Bring

Due to frequent cleaning of our kennels, we do not accept:

- Toys
- Rawhide like treats
- Bowls/Dishes
- Blankets/Beds (We can provide bedding at your request)

UPON ARRIVAL

- All pets are checked on entry for fleas and ticks and will be treated at the owner's expense if needed.
- Instructions for boarding will be taken at check-in. (Pick up date, feeding instructions, emergency contact numbers, bathing, vaccines, and medications)
- Baths are available on the day of pick-up for an additional charge.

During the Stay

- Animals are walked twice daily, more if needed/requested.
- Cats and dogs stay in different wards with each pet staying in their own kennel.
- We feed according to your instructions at check in.
- If your pet requires medical treatment, testing to maintain a healthy status, or treat communicable diseases they will be treated at the owner's expense as stated on the Boarding Permission Form.
- While away from home your pet may not want to eat. Some pets may experience stress induced weight loss and/or diarrhea despite all our efforts to prevent this from happening.

Departures

- Boarding fees are charged per night.
- If you request a bath for your pet, pick up will be after 2pm.
- Full payment is due upon pick up.
